

SPILL GUARD FOR GRAPPLE FORK FOR MONTANA ML8090 SERIES LOADERS

MOUNTING SPILL GUARD (Figure 1)

Spill Guard can be installed using tools ordinarily available. Shut off tractor engine and engage tractor brakes during installation.

- 1. Remove Spill Guard (1) from pallet.
- 2. Center spill guard (1) over top of bucket and mark holes to be drilled. Remove spill guard (1) and drill three 13/32" (.41") holes. Install grill guard (1) using 3/8-16 x 1" cap screws (4), flat washers (3), and lock nuts (5) as shown in figure 1.
- 3. Install two braces (2) between top of spill guard (1) and grapple fork uprights with 3/8-16 x 1 cap screws (4), 3/8 flat washers (3), 3/8-16 lock nuts (5).
- 4. Tighten 3/8-16 Grade 5 hardware to 26-28ft.·lbs. (35-38Nm) torque. Tighten and torque all hardware to specifications shown in general torque specifications table.
